

# RUNMAGEDDON RULEBOOK

## I. THE AIM OF THE EVENT

Organising an sport competition aiming at both supporting and promoting physical activity which are a combination of:

1. Physical activity skills;
2. Competition but at the same time cooperation skills;
3. Physical effort and great fun.

## II. ORGANIZER

All the Runmageddon events (including regular races, races for kids, trainings) are organized by Extreme Events Ltd, headquartered in Warsaw (01-640), Jana Chryzostoma Paska 21 St., registered under KRS number 0000595982 with the starting capital of 9,000 PLN and by Fundacja RUNMAGEDDON, headquartered in Warsaw (01-640), Jana Chryzostoma Paska 21 St., registered under KRS number 0000540887, called later 'Organizer'.

## III. DESCRIPTION

This event is aimed to deliver fun, while being excused by physical exercise and competition for the title of the toughest runner. The obstacles on course will verify your agility, jumping ability, stamina and above all, the mental resilience of the participants.

## IV. RACE DATE AND VENUE

1. The events take place on the territory of Poland. The venue, time and all the details regarding the race are available on the Organizer's website: [www.runmageddon.com](http://www.runmageddon.com), called later 'Website'.
2. Only registered participants can take part in the race.
3. The Organizer can change the date and/or place of the race. The Participants will be informed about that via email no later than 24 hours before the start of the race. The information will also be published on the website. The changes made will not have any financial consequences for the Organizer.
4. The organizer reserves the right to cancel the race without giving reasons. In this case, the Participant is entitled, at his option, the right to sign up for another course or to request a refund of the paid entry fee. The Organizer will inform the Participants about the cancellation of the race by posting the relevant information on the Website and in the form of an e-mail, providing details of the registration for another course or refund of the fees paid.

## V. OBSTACLES

Each race course has different number of obstacles which number and difficulty level depends on the type of the course the participant selected. Detailed information about the obstacles are on the Website.

There are 2 types of the obstacles:

- a) Natural, such as: marshes, ponds, lakes, rivers, sea, hills, mountains, trees;
- b) Artificial, such as Walls, ropes, horizontal crossings, obstacles from horse races, spider webs, gravel, water, mud or ice tanks.

## VI. PARTICIPATION

1. The competition is open for all persons who will be 18 years of age on the day of the event, except of the cases described in point 2 and 3.
2. Runmageddon Micro, Intro and Rekrut can be also attended by persons who will be 16 years of age on the day of the event and their parents or a legal guardians will sign the note (parental declaration) at the Event Office on the race date (personal presence in the Event Office and confirmation of the guardian's identity with a photo document are mandatory). The template is included at **Appendix 2**.

3. Races for the underaged:
  - Runmageddon Kids can be attended by kids at the age of 4 up to 12,
  - Runmageddon Junior can be attended by youngers at the age of 12 up to 16, only with the written consent of their parents or legal guardians presented at the Event Office on the race date (personal presence in the Event Office and confirmation of the guardian's identity with a photo document are mandatory). The template is included at **Appendix 2**.
4. In order to take place in the event it is required to:
  - a) Register by filling in an entry form;
  - b) Sign a declaration to keep the rules described in the present document;
  - c) Acknowledge, accept and agree all the dangers and risks due to the character and length of the race which may threaten health and life of the Participants;
  - d) Agree to processing personal data of the Participant included in the entry form mentioned above;
  - e) Agree to gratuitously use photos and videos with the Participant in promotional materials and media in the range described in point 6 of this document.
5. The template a written consent mentioned in point 4c , is included at **Appendix 1** to this document.
6. The Participant grant the Organizer unlimited permission to use the Participant's image in the following cases:
  - to reproduce in any form materials such as photographs, images, videotapes, recordings, motion pictures, or any other depiction of any kind of the Participant in an Event;
  - to share the materials or their copies with the sponsors in order to promote the sponsor's attendance in the event,
  - to store the materials on the Organizer's discs and computers,
  - to copy the materials,
  - to display the materials publicly in chosen by the Organizer place and time,
  - to publish the materials in the Press, on the Internet (including social media), posters and billboards,
  - to use the materials on TV and the radio,
  - to use the materials as photos from the race course.
7. The Organizer can authorize its partners and sponsors to use the materials including the Participant's image. All the official partners and sponsors are listed on the Organizer's website.
8. The Organizer reserves the right to transfer the results obtained by the participants, along with their personal data (name, birth year, city, age) to entities cooperating with the Organizer, including time measuring company on the Event, as well as to the OCR Polska Association. The transfer of results enables these entities to publish these results together with the Participant's personal data on their websites.

## **VII. REGISTRATION**

1. The number of participants is determined separately for each event.
2. To register, please fill out the electronic form available on [www.runmageddon.pl](http://www.runmageddon.pl) or [runmageddon.com](http://runmageddon.com) and make the registration payment.
3. The registration remains open up to 7 days before the date of the race.
4. The registration after the time mentioned in point 3 above is possible depending on the places availability, however, in such circumstances, the Organizer does not guarantee the completeness of the starter kit for individuals.
5. Possibility of signing up online expires 3 days before the scheduled race. After that day, the Participant can sign up only in the Event Office.
6. Possibility of signing up with a prepaid voucher or a discount code expires 5 days before the scheduled start of the event.

## **VIII. ENTRY FEE**

1. The entry fees increase as the event date approaches (see: Prices); the fee is determined by the payment date, not the registration date.
2. The entry fee value for each race is published in the Prices section on the Website.

3. The entry fee must be paid within 7 days from the registration date but not later than 3 days before the scheduled race date. The payment needs to be made by bank transfer to the bank account given at the registration process. The transfer title that has to be provided by the Participants will be generated by the registration system or the fast payment system while signing up for the race. After expiry of the above-mentioned time, the Organizer may transfer the unpaid registration to the last series of the race without notifying the Participants. As far as possible, the Organizer will inform the Participants about the planned transfer for 3-5 days prior to the race by e-mail to the Participant's e-mail address provided at registration. It is also possible to pay the entry fee at the Event Office by cash or credit card, if the event is not full yet. The Organizer is entitled to charge an administrative fee in this case.
4. A team discount is available for teams taking part in one race. The value of the discount is published on the website in the Prices section (as a rule team discount is applicable for races not shorter than Rekrut). Team discount is not applicable to those who have paid for the entry in the Event Office and not via online registration.
5. In order to collect a team discount for the event, one should use an individual code with discount amount for another Runmageddon event. Team discount cannot be joint with any other discounts and special offers, it also does not apply to the purchase of a package of several starts.
6. The entry fee cannot be assigned to other participant nor the data provided during registration cannot be changed after signing up and making the payment.

## **IX. RESIGNATION**

1. The entry fee may be refunded with no cancellation reason provided within 14 days from signing up for the race and making the payment but not later than 7 days before the scheduled event date. Beyond above – mentioned period of time, the entry fee is non-refundable.
2. In order to renounce the contract, one needs to inform the Organizer – Extreme Events via email sent to kontakt@runmageddon.pl. The message should include a clear information about renouncing the contract. The refund will be credited to the account from which the payment was made. In case of payment by card through the fast payment system on the Website, refund will be made directly to the card account.
3. If requested, the Organizer will refund all the payments made by the Participant not later than 14 days from the resignation date with no costs made on the Participant's side.
4. One may resign from taking part in the event no later than 7 days before the scheduled event date. Resignation should be made as the contract renouncement. The resignation date is the date an email to kontakt@runmageddon.pl was delivered.
5. The entry fee is non-refundable if the resignation described in point 4 above was made later than 14 days from the signing up date. In this situation, the Participant receives a discount worth 50% of the payment made. The discount can be used for another race organized by Runmageddon, the discount does not apply to packages for several starts or other promotional campaigns. The individual discount code will be sent to the Participant together with an email confirming the resignation acceptance and it is valid for 6 months from the date the resignation was received.

## **X. BENEFITS**

Included in the entry fee are:

- a) participation in the race;
- b) starter kit (more information available on the sub-pages for particular events);
- c) a souvenir medal or other gift certifying the participation in the race (given only if the race was completed and all the obstacles were overcome);
- d) a drink;
- e) basic medical care;
- f) possibility to leave your belongings in the deposit (the terms of use of the deposit published on website).

## **XI. CLASSIFICATION**

1. Awards will be given in the following categories:
  - a) Women – places I-III for the fastest women in the Elite Series

- b) Men – places I-III for the fastest men in the Elite Series
  - c) Fastest Elite teams – based on the total time of 5 best runners from the same team,
  - d) Masters – dedicated for Participants at the age of 40 and more (event date taken into consideration). Awards given only if there are at least three 40+ participants on the start list. Awards are given only to the Participants from the Elite Series. The rules for Masters Series Participants are the same as in the Elite Series,
2. Organizer has the right to give awards also in some other categories, according to the information on the sub-pages for individual events.

## **XII. SAFETY**

- 1. Organisers will put all the efforts to ensure safety during the race. Basic medical care during the event will be ensured
- 2. Due to the unique nature of the races, one must prepare for possible scratches, abrasions and injuries caused by attempts to pass the obstacles set on race track. The Participants are the only responsible for all the injuries that appeared during the race. The participants take part in the event on their own responsibility.
- 3. The Organizers reserve the right to stop the participants whom they decide to be in need of medical assistance, immediate warming up or any other form of help required.
- 4. Due to your own (and other participants) safety it is forbidden to compete in boots with spiked soles.
- 5. The Organizers reserve the right to deny the right to start to the Participants after alcohol and/or drugs consumption, being aggressive, having inappropriate outfit (e.g. boots with spiked soles) and/or to those who in any way threaten life and/or health of the other participants, the Organizers and their partners. The start fee is non-refundable.

## **XIII. PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION**

- 1. The Organizer is also personal data administrator.
- 2. Personal data of the Participants will be processed by the Organizer in order to organize the event and award the competitors. Name, surname, year of birth and city of residence of the Participants will be used in order to publish the start list, the race results and general classification (Runmageddon's League).
- 3. Personal data of the Participants will be processed by the Organizer according to generally applicable law.
- 4. The Participant has the right to modify their personal details.
- 5. It is not obligatory to provide personal data by the Participants, however it is impossible to take part in the race without them.
