

STORAGE OF PROPERTY REGULATIONS
during the Runmageddon run

[Definitions]

1. Whenever a reference is made in the Terms to:
 - a. Participant – this shall be understood as a participant in a sporting event – an obstacle course, organised as part of a series of runs called “Runmageddon”, in connection with which the storage of property service is provided;
 - b. Organisers – this shall mean Extreme Events Spółka z ograniczoną odpowiedzialnością with its registered office in Warsaw (02-758), ul. Śródziemnomorska 35, KRS: 0000535982 and Fundacja RUNMAGEDDON with its registered office in Warsaw (02-758), ul. Śródziemnomorska 35, KRS: 0000540887;
 - c. Run – this shall mean an obstacle race organised as part of a series of runs called “Runmageddon”, in connection with which the storage of property service is provided;
 - d. Starting number – this shall mean the number under which the Participant has been entered by the Organisers for the purpose of holding the Run and of which the Participant was informed prior to the commencement of the Run.

[Putting in storage]

2. The Participant shall be entitled to hand in only hand-held Items for the time of the Run, on the terms set out in these Regulations.
3. The Participant shall confirm the handing over of the hand-held items by indicating the starting number (from the armband).
4. The items handed over for safekeeping shall be kept by the Organizers in the container (bag) made available to the Participant in the designated place. However, depending on the place where the Run is organized, the Organizers may not provide a separate lockable deposit room, and the hand-held items put into storage may be stored in conditions that expose them to weather conditions prevailing during the Run.
5. Under these Regulations “hand-held items” are objects:
 - a. Which, due to their own characteristics, i.e. dimensions, material, method of use, etc., are suitable for storage in the conditions specified in clause 4 of these Regulations.
 - b. With the total value not exceeding PLN 500.

[No placing in storage of items other than hand-held items, liability of the Participant]

6. Participants shall not be allowed to place in storage items that do not meet the conditions referred to in clause 5 of these Regulations, in particular items exceeding the value referred to in clause 5 above, items that may break, become waterlogged, crushed. The Participant

shall be liable for damage caused by the violation of the above prohibition to the Organizers, third parties, as well as for damage done to these items and for their loss.

7. As far as possible, the Organizers may agree to store items that are not handheld items within the meaning of these Regulations, however, only after prior presentation of such items by the Participant, drawing up an appropriate transfer and receipt report, in which the representative of the Organizer confirms the acceptance of these items for storage and payment by the Participant of the storage fee, determined individually depending on the item accepted for safekeeping.

[Collection of items placed in storage]

8. The container (bag) in which the items placed for safekeeping are kept is marked with the starting number of the Participant.
9. Only the Participant who handed over these items for storage shall be entitled to collect them, after providing the following verification data: starting number and other verification data provided by the Organizer.
10. Items deposited for safekeeping should be picked up at the place of their deposit, immediately after the end of the Run. The Participant may pick up the items earlier.
11. If the items are not collected at the time and place specified in clause 9, the Participant shall be obliged to pay to the Organizers a storage fee of PLN 50 for each day of delay. After the lapse of 14 days from the day on which the Participant placed the items for safekeeping, the Organizers shall have the right to destroy any unclaimed items at the expense of the Participant. The Organizers may charge the Participant with the cost of shipment of items not collected by him to the address indicated by the Participant.
12. The Participant confirms the receipt of items by indicating the armband with the starting number, which will be cut off after collecting the items.
